Mayor Pro Tem Franklin conducted the meeting. She called the meeting to order and led the pledge of allegiance at 9:00 a.m.

**1. Out-of State Travel Request to and from Sealy, TX for Deming Police Department personnel to pick up special equipment:**

Chief Gigante presented this item to Mayor Pro Tem and Council. He stated that the City Police Department had been awarded a MRAP-Mine Resistant Armored Personnel Carrier through the Homeland Security Office in Santa Fe, and that it would need to be picked up at the factory in Sealy, Texas.

Chief Gigante requests that Council allow 2 personnel to pick up and bring the equipment home. Both personnel will travel to Texas and the City unit will escort the other vehicle.

Chief Gigante also stated that at the end of the life cycle of the MRAP, the vehicle would need to be returned to Holloman AFB or Ft. Bliss.

Councilor Sanchez asked if staff would need to receive special training to maintain the vehicle. Chief Gigante stated that they would not due to the fact that the motor is a common International Motor and the parts are available at any local auto part store.


Chief Gigante also mentioned that the special vehicle would be intended for use with the SWAT Team, and would also be used to assist for any other need with partnering agencies.

Mayor Pro Tem Franklin entertained a motion on this request. Councilor Sanchez made a motion to approve the out-of-state travel request for 2 Police Department personnel to travel to and from Sealy, TX to pick up special equipment. Councilor Milo seconded the motion, motion carried unanimously.


